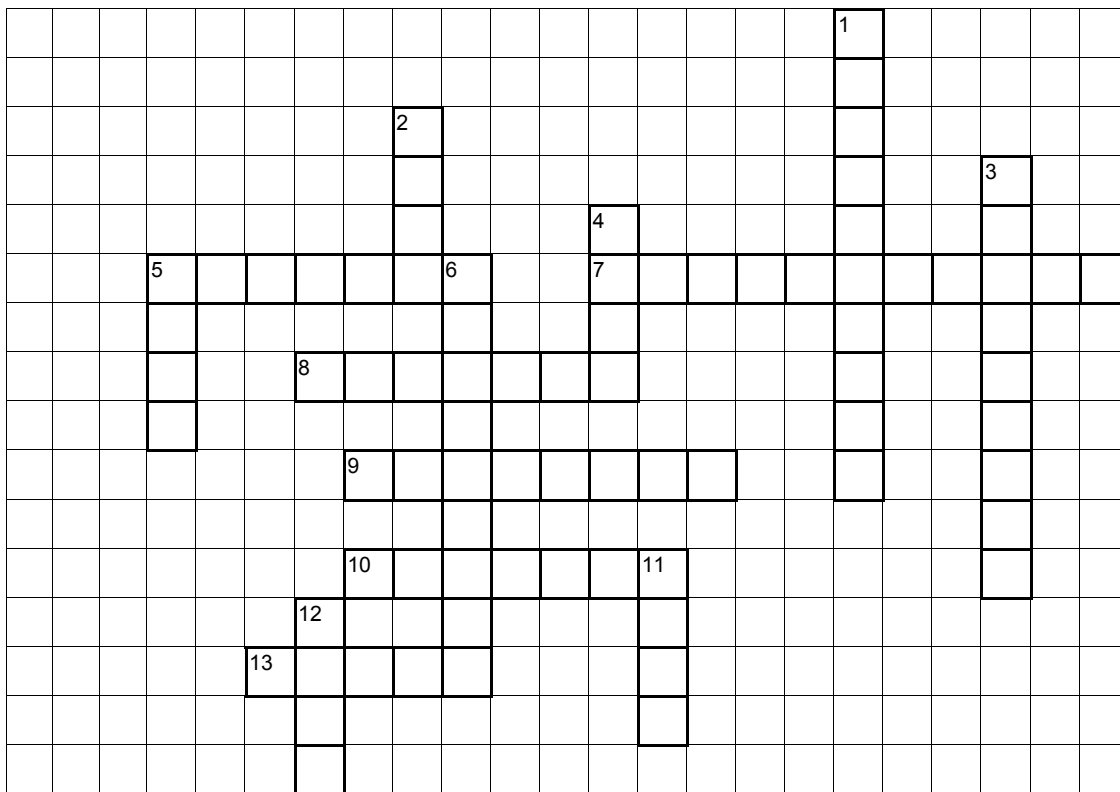


Ceramic Terms

- 5 To make scratches or creases in pieces of clay be joined together
- 7 A state of clay that strong enough to support itself, but still can be worked
- 8 A state of clay where the moisture has evaporated leaving the clay unworkable, but ready for firing
- 9 Moving and shaping clay, usually using the fingers
- 10 Can be easily manipulated - modeled, molded or pressed into a desired shape; malleable
- 13 A thin coating of minerals which produces a glassy transparent or colored coating on bisque ware

Down

- 1 Clay that has been fired once in the kiln
- 2 Furnace for firing clay which can achieve temperatures up to 2500 °f. Power by gas, wood, or electric
- 3 Clay that has been glazed and fired a second time in the kiln
- 4 Fine-grained earth materials formed by the decomposition of igneous rock
- 5 A flat piece of clay
- 6 Finished leather hard or bone dry clay pieces not yet fired
- 11 A rounded tube/snake like length of clay
- 12 Watered down clay that is used in the joining of two pieces of clay together
